**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Feed STEAKMAKER STOCKER STARTER 1X at 1 lb per 100 lb bodyweight with additional forage for receiving or starting cattle. Maximum feeding rate is 11 lb per head per day.

Do not allow animals to run out of feed. Provide adequate bunk space for each animal. Bunks should be well protected and well managed to prevent accumulation of fines, wet and moldy feed. When making a ration change, allow at least five days for animals to adjust to the new ration. When fed from a self-feeder, adjust the feeder to minimize quantity of feed accumulations in trough and offer additional long-stemmed hay. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

In groups of cattle there are certain animals which can experience digestive disturbances from over-eating feed. Weather changes, enterotoxemia and poor feeding practices all can result in erratic feed consumption and can increase the incidence of digestive problems. Always follow directions and good animal health and feeding practices.

**Usage Tips**

SteakMaker Stocker Starter 1X is ideal for starting home-raised cattle and cattle that have been lightly stressed by weaning and/or shipment. This is the perfect product to use on cattle that are being straightened out prior to grass turn-out and for pre-conditioning programs like VAC-45. SteakMaker Stocker Starter 1x is a semi-complete feed that should be fed with moderate amounts of roughage. The wide variety of feed additives and levels allows a producer to tailor his feeding program to his own particular needs. Feed SteakMaker Stocker Starter 1X up to 1% of the animal's body weight, while providing a source of excellent quality long-stemmed grass, grass-legume, or small grain hay.

Do not allow animals to run out of feed. Provide adequate bunk space for each animal. Bunks should be well protected and well managed to prevent accumulation of fines, wet and moldy feed. Offer additional long-stemmed hay. Fermented feeds (high moisture grains, silage) should be limited to 10% of the diet for starting young or heavily stressed cattle. When making a ration change, allow at least 5 days for animals to adjust to the new ration. Stressed cattle should be placed in a clean, non-crowded environment. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.

In groups of cattle there are certain animals which can experience digestive disturbances from overeating feed. Weather changes, enterotoxemia and poor feeding practices all can result in erratic feed consumption and can increase the incidence of digestive problems. Always follow directions and good animal health and feeding practices.

**With AS700 feeds, feed for 28 days. There is a 7 day withdrawal prior to slaughter.**
