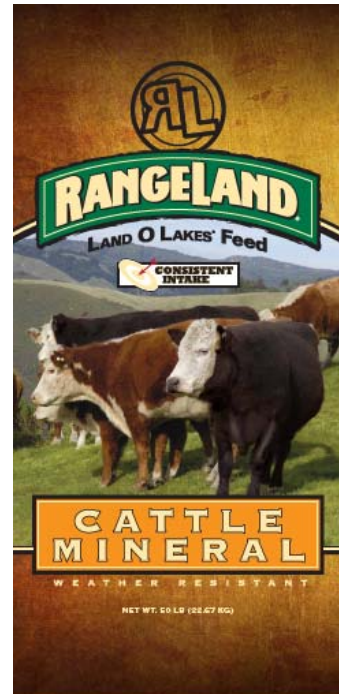

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed this product free choice to cattle grazing green, fast-growing forage. Feed this product 1 to 2 weeks before cattle are placed on pasture. Optimum intake is 2 ounces per head per day.

Cattle receiving phosphorus deficient diets may over-consume this product when it is first offered. Place the mineral feeder near the water supply or in the animals' loafing area. Put out fresh mineral at least once per week. Free choice salt is not required with this mineral. Provide fresh, clean water near the feeding area.

To assure adequate mineral intake, **remove all other salt and mineral products**. Have an adequate water supply available and place the mineral feeder near the water supply or in the animals' loafing areas. Put out fresh mineral at least once a week.
